#### **Enhancing English Proficiency: A Comprehensive Training Program**

#### Report

On June 19, 2020, the Department of English organized a training program titled "Enhancing English Proficiency" at the Seminar Hall, beginning at 10 AM. The program, attended by 35 students, was inaugurated by Dr. Jayan Eracheri Illam, Principal, who emphasized the importance of English proficiency for academic and professional success. The training was led by G S Aravind, Assistant Professor from the Department of English.

The morning session commenced with a focus on grammar and usage. This part of the program covered essential grammar rules such as tense usage, sentence structure, and common grammatical errors. Participants engaged in various exercises designed to reinforce their grammatical skills. Following a short break, the vocabulary development session was held. This session aimed to enhance participants' vocabulary through activities that explored context clues, synonyms, and antonyms.

Interactive exercises allowed students to practice and apply new vocabulary in meaningful contexts.

After a lunch break, the afternoon sessions began with a focus on pronunciation and speaking skills. This segment addressed correct pronunciation, intonation, and fluency, with students participating in guided speaking exercises and discussions to improve their spoken English. #### Discover Yoga: Beginner's Training Workshop


#### Report



#### **Training Programme on Stress Management for Mental Wellness**


#### Report


covered topics such as identifying stressors, coping mechanisms, and practical exercises for reducing stress.

departmental seminars at the college. This initiative not only provided students with valuable practical skills but also contributed to the efficient and sustainable management of seminar supplies within the institution.






