## NEP Implementation

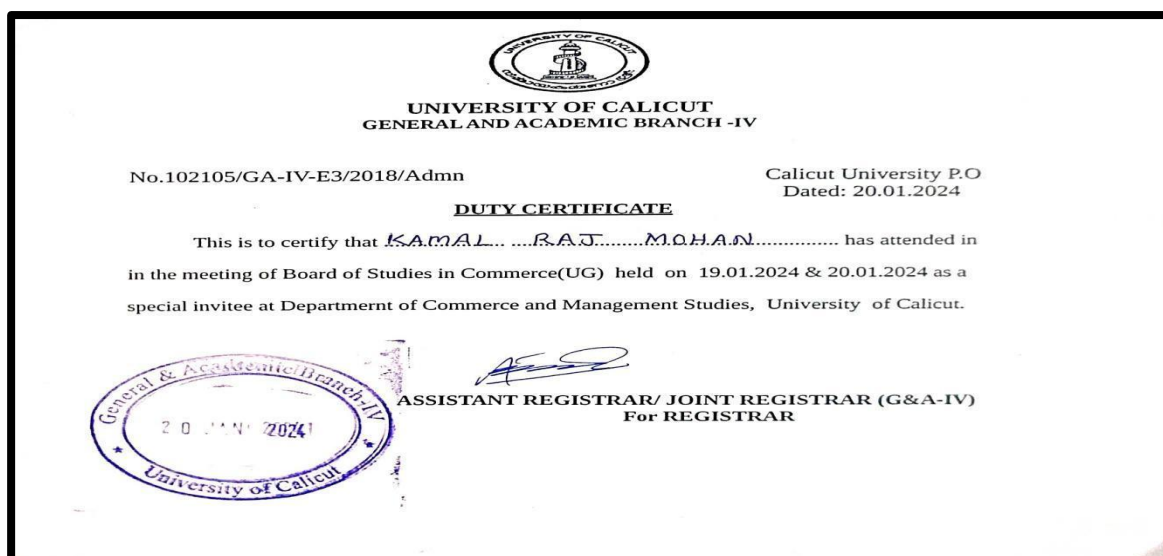

## **II. Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)**

The Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is central to the National Education Policy 2020. Our college, affiliated with the University of Calicut, follows the Credit and Semester System (CBCSS) as per university guidelines. This system assigns credits based on instructional hours and allows for continuous assessment through internal evaluations and end-semester exams. It also offers flexibility for students to choose electives and tailor their education.

Starting this academic year, we will adopt ABC and register students in the National Academic Depository in alignment with the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP). The University Grants Commission's ABC allows credit transfer among institutions, enabling students to take up to one course per semester from other colleges, with a maximum of four courses (16 credits) in four years. Students discontinuing before three years will receive a "Courses cum Credits Certificate" for future re-entry. Additionally, a DIGILOCKER system will be established to manage these credits.

## **III. Skill Development**

In pursuit of the holistic development of our students, the College places great emphasis on skill development to equip them for success in their future careers. Our institution ensures that students actively engage in various programs like the Additional Skill Acquisition Program (ASAP), Work Readiness Program, and Walk With a Scholar Program (WWS).

Fostering a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship is achieved through initiatives such as the Entrepreneurship Development Club, Youth Innovation Program, and the Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Cell. Notably, amid the challenges posed by COVID-19, the institution coordinated skill-building activities like sanitizer and mask production through the Entrepreneurship Development club and NSS. Additionally, efforts were made to enhance students' skills through activities like file, letter pad, and pen making, which were also organized by the Entrepreneurship Development Club and NSS.

It is evident that our institution is committed to enhancing the skill development of our students by focusing on life skills, soft skills, language skills, and ICT skills, thereby demonstrating our dedication to a comprehensive educational approach.

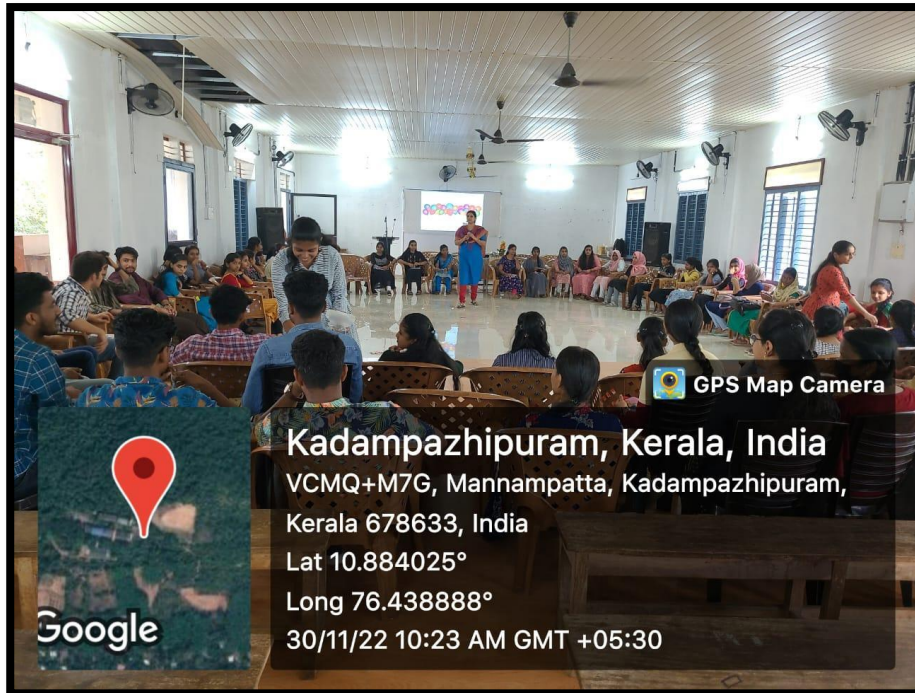

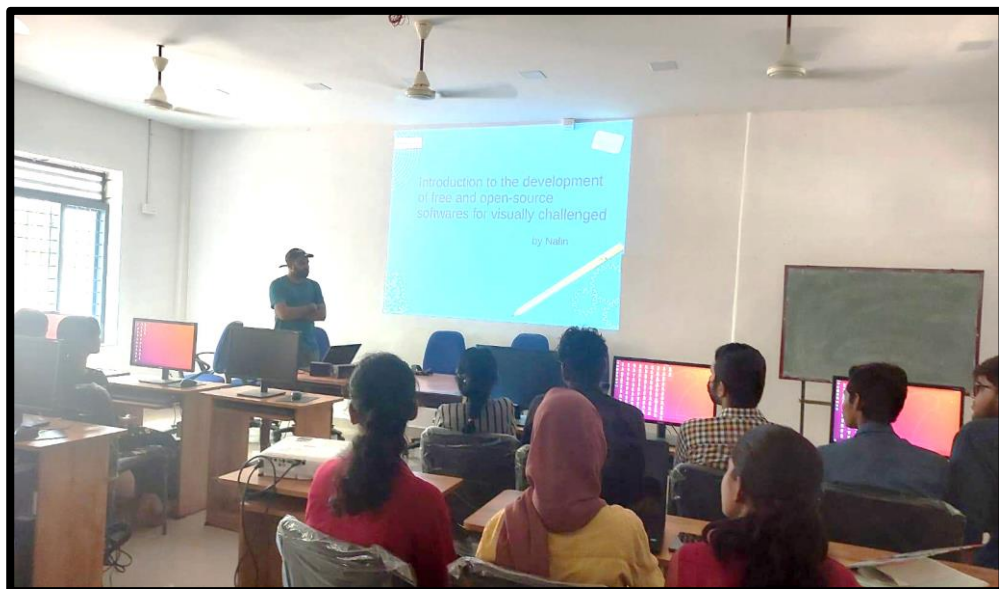

Sreekrishnapuram V. T. Bhattathiripad College is a government aided arts and science college in Palakkad district of Kerala affiliated to the university of Calicut. In the year 2019 the college got approval from UGC to execute an interdisciplinary research project under scheme of UGC STRIDE Component 1 on the topic **Vedic Education System in Kerala - A Comprehensive Scientific and Interdisciplinary Analysis.**

**Aim of The Course**

Vedas are learned through the chanting tradition of oral transmission and that's how the name sruti came in to being. Kerala followed a unique and systematic method of Vedic teaching and learning system in several aspects.



Among them the pronunciation of syllables with the application of phonetic rules and the usage of accent system through the Hastamudras are played a vital role in preserving Vedic studies. Vedic phonetics, (mainly examined by the **Sikshas** and **Pratisakhya**) is an area of science which explored a vast area of knowledge on the sound production and articulation. In Kerala, Tamil chanting traditions are also living with some awesome peculiarities in its structure and content.

The course aims to explore the salient features and significance of chanting traditions of Kerala, to pave a path in the field of research to Vedic phonetics and its derivations in Indian linguistics and also to put forward the discourses in the Tamil traditions living in Kerala which are not much poured. This course is meant to promote and motivate the institutions and students those who are teaching and learning the Vedas traditionally.

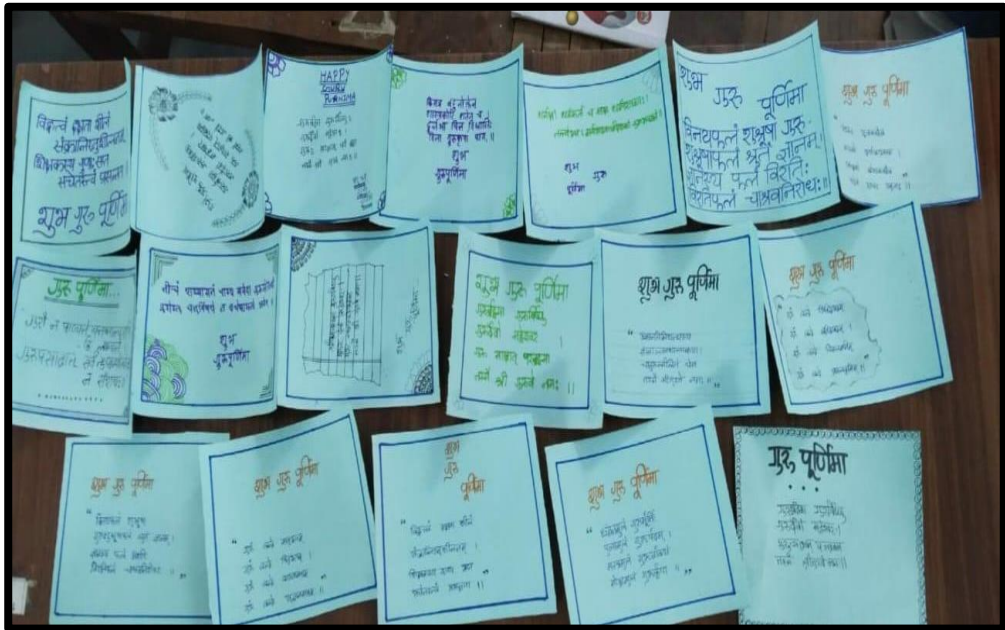

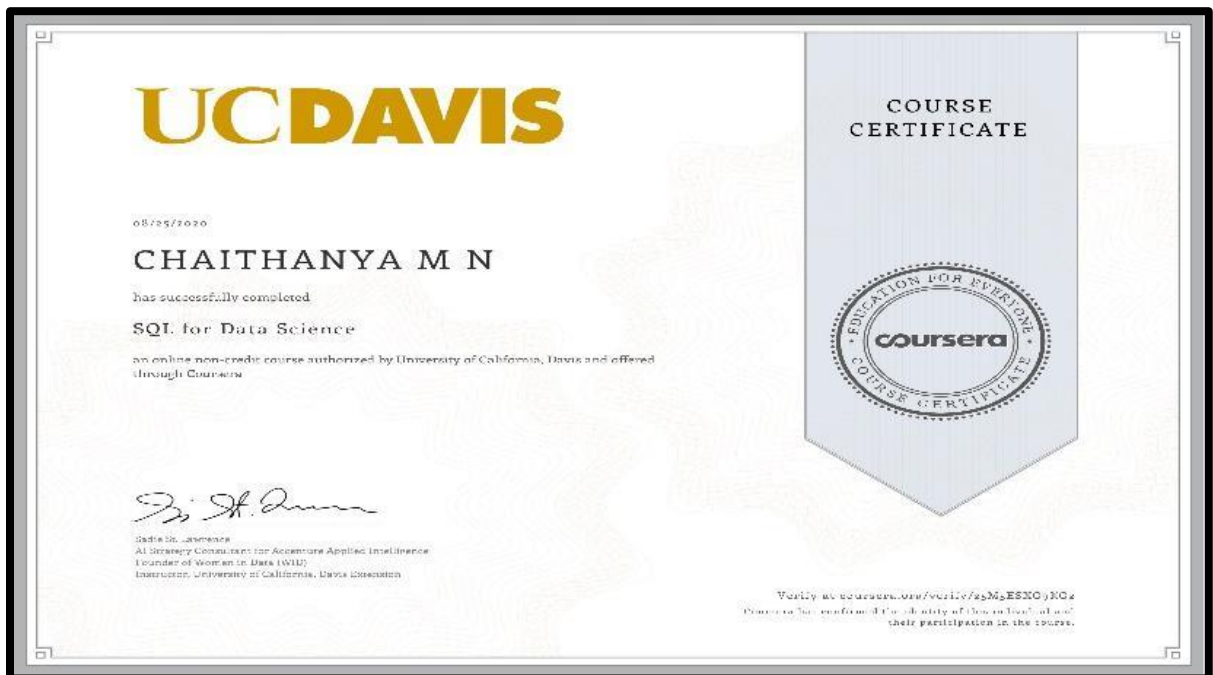

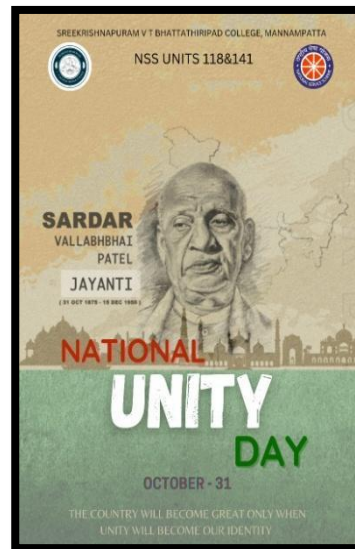
