Sree Sankara Trust was established in 1965 in Peringara, Kerala, by a group of well-wishers from the Namboothiri community, led by founder Chairman Sri P.N. Namboothiri. It is registered under the Literary, Scientific, and Charitable Societies Registration Act of 1955.

The Trust is dedicated to the ideals and philosophies of Jagadguru Sree Sankaracharya, the renowned Indian saint and proponent of the Advaita Philosophy. The Trust's first educational institution, Sree Sankara Vidyapeedam College (Government Aided), was established in Perumbavoor near Kalady, the birthplace of Sree Sankaracharya. The land for the college was generously donated by the local Namboothiri community. Affiliated with Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, this college offers courses up to the postgraduate level.

The second college, Sreekrishnapuram V. T. Bhathathirippad College (Government Aided), in Palakkad District, is named after the esteemed social reformer and writer V.T. Bhattathiripad. This college is affiliated with University of Calicut and also provides education up to the postgraduate level.

The third institution, another Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College, is located in the picturesque Nagaroor valleys of Thiruvananthapuram District. This self-financing college, affiliated with the University of Kerala, sits on a sprawling 30-acre campus, offering tremendous potential for future growth into a prominent educational complex.

Sree Sankara College (Government Aided), in Nagaroor, the fourth institution by the Sree Sankara Trust, was founded in 2018. Affiliated with the

University of Kerala, SSC offers a range of undergraduate courses. The college is committed to providing quality education and fostering a supportive learning environment.

PROFILE OF THE INSTITUTE

Sreekrishnapuram V. T. Bhattathiripad College, a first-grade Government Aided College, is affiliated with the University of Calicut. Established in 1982, the college serves the rural and backward regions of Sreekrishnapuram in the Palakkad district of Kerala. Named after V. T. Bhattathiripad, a pioneer of social revolution in Kerala, the college aims to promote higher education. Today, the college offers six Undergraduate Degree courses and three Postgraduate Degree courses.

In recognition of its quality and standards, the college is included under sections 12(B) and 2(f) of the UGC Act 1956, as per the letter No: F8-91/99(CP-P-1) dated 20-03-2000 from the Secretary of the UGC. The college was re-accredited with a B+ grade by NAAC in 2016.

1. World Environment Day

TRAINING PLACEMENT CELL INITIATIVES

Work Readiness Programme

The Work Readiness Programme is a 15 - hour module designed to provide direction to candidates to improve their interview skills and articulate their thoughts confidently in front of an interview panel. The module is inclusive of interview etiquette, resume preparation, presentation skills, group discussions, job-related Q & A, soft skills, etc. The programme was rolled out by the Kerala Knowledge Economy Mission (KKEM), in collaboration with ASAP Kerala. 


Phase 2


Activity 5: Women Entrepreneurship Day Celebration and Chart Exhibition




EVENTS AT DEPARTMENT LEVEL

Diploma in Computer Applications (DCA) Course


