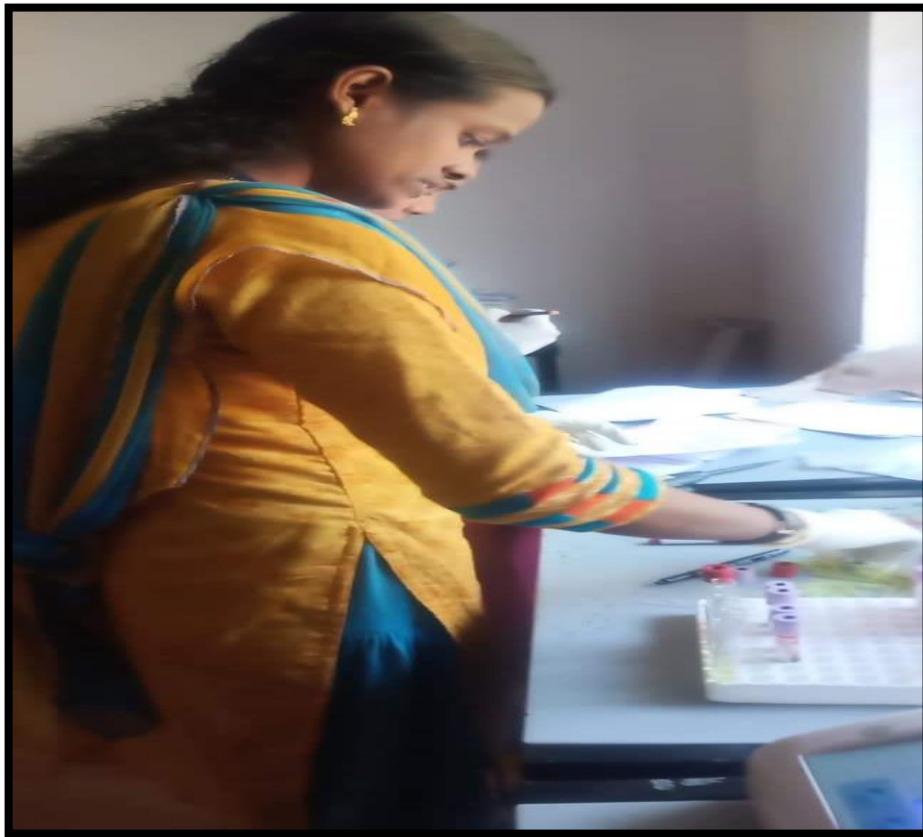

### Report on Activity

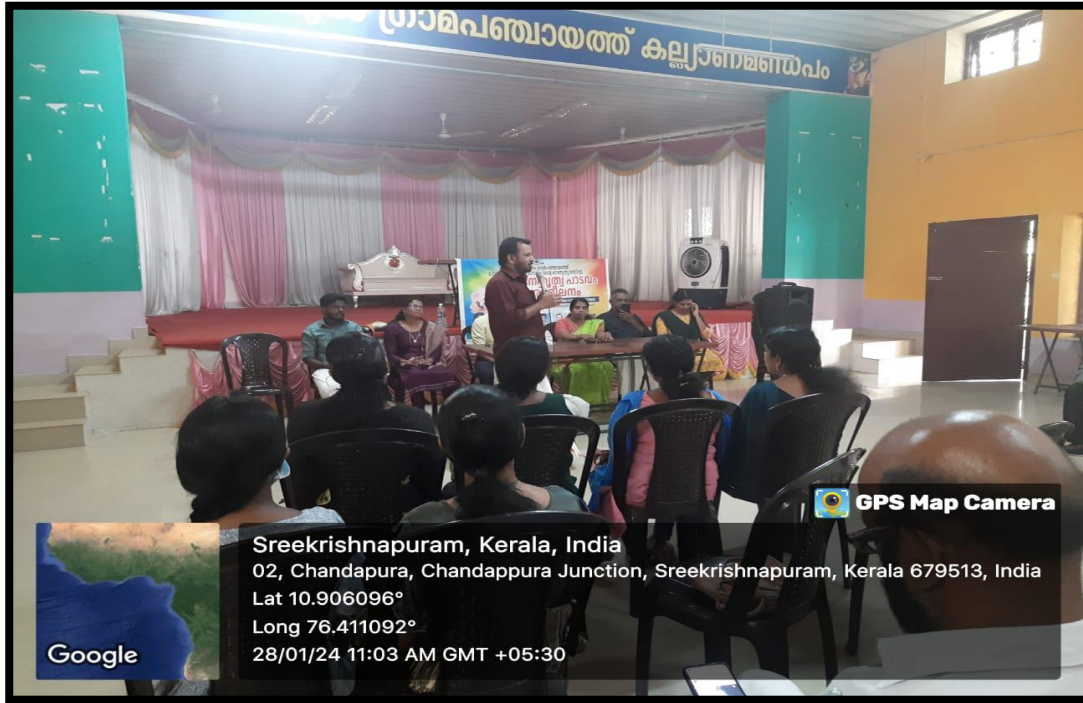
